REGISTRATION & PRIZES

Online registration is available thru bikereg.com with early registration closing Nov. 14th at 11:59pm CST. On-site registration will be \$35 for adults and \$15 for juniors. Additional race registrations per day are \$10 each. Initial race registration fee includes a discounted \$5 Texas State Parks entrance and use fee for the race participant only. Additional adults entering the park who are not paid race participants will be charged the standard \$7 Texas State Parks entrance and use fee unless your vehicle has a valid, annual Texas State Parks pass. Those categories sharing start times will have separate prizes and be scored separately per TXBRA CX State Cup rules.

RACE NOTES & VENUE

Current USAC road or mountain annual or one-day license required (USAC one-day license and annual licenses available for purchase). All USAC rules apply (remember: helmets must be worn at all times while on your bicycle; mountain bikes are permitted, no bar-ends). Races run rain or shine, no refunds. No warm-up on the course while races are in progress (disqualification may occur). Promoter reserves the right to combine/change races & payout if a minimum of 10 riders per category is not met.
